# 1. Approval of January 11, 2023 Meeting Minutes

Councilwoman Solange Whitehead made a motion to approve the Meeting Minutes of January 11, 2023. Councilwoman Tammy Caputi seconded the motion. Mayor David D. Ortega, Councilwoman Tammy Caputi and Councilwoman Solange Whitehead voted in the affirmative. Scottsdale Unified School District Joint Advisory Committee on Education members Dr. Scott Menzel, Dr. Libby Hart-Wells and Amy Carney voted in the affirmative. Scottsdale Community College Joint Advisory Committee on Education members Dr. Eric Leshinskie and Melanie Burm voted in the affirmative; there were no dissenting votes

# 2. Accomplishments and Updates

Dr. Menzel reported that there would be 41 Coronado Promise Scholarship awardees instead of the typical 25. Dr. Leshinskie reported that meetings had been taking place between Scottsdale Unified School District and Scottsdale Community College to expand the dual enrollment program which was discussed in the January 11<sup>th</sup> Meeting.

# 3. <u>Scottsdale Internship Program Update</u>

Stephanie Zamora, Management Associate in the City Manager's office provided the update on to the development of additional service-learning employment opportunities for high school and community college students with an overview of recommendations to establish a centralized internship program including methods to formalize the program. The following feedback was provided:

- Mayor Ortega mentioned ensuring that interns are set up for success from the beginning with proper onboarding
- Councilwoman Caputi mentioned structuring the program so that we stay in touch with interns once their program is complete.
- Dr. Libby Hart-Wells mentioned the importance of a cohort model to the success of interns and also singular application for interns who are then assigned a location.
- Dr. Leshinskie noted that internships for all levels is important, community college interns maybe more likely to stay than a High School intern who then goes out of state for college.
