1. Approval of Minutes

a. Regular Meeting: December 21, 2023

BOARD MEMBER SPRINGBORN MOVED TO APPROVE AS PRESENTED THE REGULAR SESSION MEETING MINUTES FROM THE DECEMBER 21, 2023, PSPRS FIRE LOCAL BOARD MEETING. BOARD MEMBER CAVNER SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED FOUR (4) TO ZERO (0) BY ROLL CALL VOTE. CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS BOYD, CAVNER, AND SPRINGBORN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. BOARD MEMBER LEAVITT ABSTAINED.

2. Discussion and possible action on the Accidental Disability Retirement Application of Fire Engineer Richard Stuve

Ms. Asmus noted that Fire Engineer Richard Stuve has 18.587 years of service. His monthly benefit will be \$4,809.27. All of his paperwork is in order.

Richard Stuve thanked the Board for their time and consideration.

Chair Meraz noted that the Board did receive an amendment to the doctor 's initial report, indicating his injury was not due to a preexisting condition.

CHAIR MERAZ, BOARD MEMBERS BOYD, CAVNER, LEAVITT, AND SPRINGBORN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. THERE WERE NO DISSENTING VOTES.

Board Members reviewed and agreed upon answers to questions on the P5-PBA form.

3. Induction of new City of Scottsdale Firefighters into PSPRS

There were no new inductees.

4. Report to the Board on recently completed service transfers, if any

There were no recently completed service transfers.

5. Board suggestions for upcoming agenda items

Ms. Asmus recalled earlier discussion about moving the board meetings due to a conflict in Ms. Boyd<sup>2</sup>'s calendar. She noted that her executive team meeting schedule would not be a conflict if the PSPRS board meetings were moved to the second Thursday of the month or would have one conflict if moved to the fourth Thursday of the month.
