

ORDINANCE NO. 4490

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SCOTTSDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING
SECTION 16-188 CONCERNING SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR
LICENSE APPROVALS

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 4-203.02 allows the governing body of a city or town to designate who can approve special event liquor licenses on behalf of the governing body or town; and

WHEREAS, special event liquor licenses are processed by Business Services of the City Treasurer's Office in consultation with other City departments such as the Police Department and Planning and the City now wishes to designate the City's Business Services Director as the City's designee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. Scottsdale Revised Code Section 16-188 is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 16-188. - Special event liquor licenses; fees.

(a) Any person desiring a special event license pursuant to A.R.S. § 4-203.02, shall make application with the city twenty (20) days prior to the date for which the special event license is sought.


(b) Application shall be made upon forms furnished by the city and made available by the ~~customer~~ business services director or designee. A nonrefundable fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per day shall be paid at the time of making application.

(c) City staff shall review the application and make a recommendation to the mayor, business services director who shall approve or deny the application.

(d) For purposes of this section, business services director has the same meaning as provided for in section 16-3.


