– **Councilmember Korte made a motion to approve the Emergency Meeting Minutes of May 31, 2020. Councilwoman Littlefield seconded the motion, which carried 7/0, by a roll call vote, with Mayor Lane; Vice Mayor Whitehead; and Councilmembers Klapp, Korte, Littlefield, Milhaven, and Phillips voting in the affirmative.**
- Proclamation and Declaration of Emergency**
Request: Pursuant to Scottsdale Revised Code Section 10-3, consider approving a motion either continuing or terminating the Emergency Proclamation declared by Mayor Lane on May 31, 2020, as a result of the looting and unrest which began on May 30, 2020. The Emergency Proclamation is scheduled to expire on June 7, 2020, unless further extended.

Action will be taken by a Roll Call vote.
– **Councilwoman Milhaven made a motion to approve the Proclamation and Declaration of Emergency, but amend it to extend to June 16, 2020, and recommend that Mayor Lane continue his second proclamation delegating local curfew authority to the Chief of Police to also extend to June 16, 2020. Councilwoman Klapp seconded the motion, which carried 7/0, by roll call vote, with Mayor Lane; Vice Mayor Whitehead; and Councilmembers Klapp, Korte, Littlefield, Milhaven, and Phillips voting in the affirmative.**
