Section 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public that a special meeting of the Scottsdale Mountain Community Facilities District of Scottsdale, Arizona, open to the public, will be held on Tuesday, June 7, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. or immediately following the meeting of the Scottsdale City Council, in the City Hall Kiva Forum, 3939 N. Drinkwater Boulevard.

Community Facilities Districts Board of Directors meetings are also televised on Cox Cable Channel 11 and streamed online at ScottsdaleAZ.gov (search "live stream") to allow the public to listen/view the meeting in progress.

Registration for In-Person public comment is available online by completing a Request to Speak form. In-Person Public Comment Request to Speak forms must be submitted no later than 90 minutes before the start of the meeting. Additionally, In-Person meeting attendees may submit a Request to Speak form utilizing the kiosk located in the foyer area of City Hall for each agenda item they wish to address. Forms must be submitted and received before the Chairman announces the agenda item.

Written public comment may be submitted in-person by completing a yellow written public comment card or electronically by completing a Written Public Comment form. Written public comment received during the meeting will be shared with the Board of Directors. Written comments that are submitted electronically at least 90 minutes before the meeting will be emailed to the Board of Directors and posted online prior to the meeting.
