

CITY OF SCOTTSDALE – OFFICE OF THE MAYOR *Emergency Proclamation No. 08-20-2020

WHEREAS, the City remains under a state of emergency that was declared on March 18, 2020, in response to the spread of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency in Arizona due to the COVID-19 outbreak continues to exist; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, on June 17, 2020, issued Executive Order 2020-40 providing that a County, City, or Town may adopt and enforce policies requiring wearing a mask covering their mouth and nose ("face covering") for the purpose of mitigating the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2020 pursuant to the authority granted in Executive Order 2020-40, the Mayor of the City of Scottsdale issued Emergency Proclamation No. 06-18-2020 requiring the use of face coverings within the City of Scottsdale to help build public confidence in the continued and safe reopening of the Arizona economy and protect the public health; and

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Scottsdale extended Emergency Proclamation No. 6-18-2020 pursuant to Emergency Proclamation No. 7-17-2020 till August 20, 2002; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. §26-311 and S.R.C. §10-3, the Mayor of the City of Scottsdale has determined that there continues to be a risk to the safety of people and property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W.J. "Jim" Lane, as Mayor of the City of Scottsdale, County of Maricopa, State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me, and in accordance with law, in addition to the prior Proclamation of Emergency dated March 18, 2020, do hereby proclaim and declare to the People of the City of Scottsdale as follows:

1. Emergency Proclamation No. 06-18-2020 concerning the use of face coverings is hereby extended in its entirety and shall remain in place until repealed. In consideration of Maricopa County's mask requirement and all relative statistical and informational indicators, it shall be periodically reviewed by the Mayor for possible repeal or revision throughout the time it remains in effect.
