
Angled street parking <u>with</u> centerline stripe Acceptable placement criteria shown in **BLUE**

Food truck vehicle must be parked within delineated parking space, 10' clear roadway (min) between vehicle and painted centerline. Centerline may be double yellow or dashed skip lines. <u>Food delivery counter must be</u> <u>adjacent to acceptable ADA service area.</u>



Angled street parking on 2-way street without centerline stripe

Acceptable placement criteria shown in **BLUE**

Food truck vehicle must be parked within delineated parking space, 20' clear roadway (min) between adjacent parked vehicles or street features. Food delivery counter <u>must be adjacent to acceptable ADA service area.</u>




Parallel street parking on 2-way street with marked parking stalls

Acceptable placement criteria shown in **BLUE**

Food truck vehicle must be parked within a single delineated parking space. Food delivery counter must be adjacent to acceptable ADA service area.





= Food truck prohibited parking examples*

- Within 50ft of an intersection
- Within any portion of a striped safety zone 2
- Within a driveway or alley opening 3
- Occupying two striped parking spaces 4
- Blocking a sidewalk or crosswalk
- Or anyplace prohibited with signs or curb markings
