

FARMERS MARKET NORTH SCOTTSDALE HIGH PRIORITY SAFETY PROTOCOLS-  
UPDATED 2/18/21

Farmers Market North Scottsdale is committed to upholding any and all ADHS/CDC Guidelines in all recommended areas. Our Market Team, which includes our Vendors have and will continue to make this a priority as we focus on the following high priority areas throughout the Market.

1. Hand hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette- Will require Vendors to have hand sanitizers at all tables, while wearing proper respiratory gear at all times. Signage will be displayed regarding social distancing procedures.
2. ADHS/CDC Masks guidelines and the Citywide Mask Mandate, which went into effect on January 13, 2021 will be adhered to and enforced to all in attendance. Signage will be displayed at the entrance and throughout the market venue. Vendors will not sell any items to those without masks!
3. Training and retraining of Proper Protocols of ADHS/CDC guidelines will be continued for all Staff and Vendors (new/olds) throughout our Market Season.
4. Vendor Booth Protocols will be followed as stated on the CDC/ADHS Guidelines – Our goal is to do less exchanging of payment options, distancing amongst customers, cleaning and disinfecting locations in between customers.
5. Vendor Tents will follow the proposed 6’ buffer between each one.
6. Market Staff will have 2 additional staff Members to enforce masks and social distancing. We will hold Vendors accountable to enforcing this as well!

VENDOR PROTOCOLS –

Gloves/masks are required per CDD/ADHS Guidelines. We do take into account non-COVID Health issues. Each situation will be handled accordingly as they come up.

- Hand Sanitizers will be accessible at each table
- If sick, ask to stay home

RESTROOMS:

The DC Ranch Village Health Club will provide restrooms for both Vendors and Customers attending the Market Venue.

FOOD VENDOR PROTOCOLS –

- Disposable utensils/napkins are separated and NO sharing of these items

SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOL –

- Signage is placed throughout the Market requiring all to social distance per a “6 ft apart” guideline.
- Vendors are required to uphold these guidelines during our market hours.
- Foot traffic will be monitored and moved to ensure that not too many are congregating in one area.

Lastly, Farmers Market North Scottsdale is very Serious to upholding all ADHS/CDC Guidelines.
