

# Green Bee Farmers Market

## Safety Plan

Market will be set up to adhere to the CDC Guidelines and state and local mandates for outdoor events where the crowd will be less than 5 people at any given moment and where social distancing is easily obtained.

Social distancing is achieved by altering the market layout to create barriers that force social distancing.

Market is set up with one entrance and one exit. People must wait their turn to cycle through to pickup their order. It is designed so the only thing customers touch is their own order.

Other portions of the market layout consist of tables set up in random locations for no contact pickup.

We also offer no contact delivery to customers vehicles.

Health and Safety guidelines are sent out at the bottom of our weekly emails for ordering, and reminders are displayed on site.

Hand Sanitizer is available on site as well as pre-packaged hand wipes.

Masks will be available on site for purchase.

In the event someone comes to market unprepared and refuses to purchase a mask, they will be asked to return to their car, and I will bring them their order for contactless pickup and invoice payment.

Enforcement of safety protocols will be done by me, or in the event staff is hired at a later date, they will be educated on the safety protocols and be required to enforce them.

For the safety of others, I have been tested, and will continue to be tested on a regular basis. Market will be cancelled if I am feeling unwell or suspect I may be sick.

We ran several versions of this setup last season, with no issues. The Community has been very respectful to others and understanding of these new guidelines, I don't foresee any future problems.
