

Re: **Written Safety Plan** **Highline Auto Cars n Coffee Event**

Health and Safety is Top Priority. We encourage everyone to follow the CDC's advice for preventative behaviors including:

-If you think or know you've been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, please stay home and look forward to attending next time. It's a smart idea to quarantine yourself for 14 days and consider getting tested.

-Face masks are required for attendance to the event.

-Masks will be provided to show cars and attendees upon arrival to the event courtesy of One Armor. Masks will also be available throughout the event to any guest who does not have one. **If you are unwilling to wear a mask, please do not attend the event.** Unless you are eating or drinking you MUST wear a mask at all times.

-Hand Sanitizing and Disinfectant stations with formulas recommended by the CDC will be available throughout the event.

-Practice Social Distancing by maintaining 6 ft distance recommendation.

-Cleaning and disinfecting entrance door handles, handrails and restrooms throughout the day.

-Professional group of volunteers and security staff onsite focusing on promoting social distancing as well as enforce mask-wearing.

- Signage throughout the event specifically relating to 6ft social distancing as well as mandatory mask policy.

- Both Show Cars and Attendees will enter the event through the Goldwater entrance to park in the reserved/assigned show car area or in the Parking Garage.

Respecting our host property and neighbors is a top priority. Volunteers – hired staff will be notifying event host about cars that do the following while coming into or exiting the event:

- **Revsing engine, speeding, burning out / spinning tires while entering or exiting the event. (If we are notified of a vehicle doing any of the mentioned items they will be flagged and banned from future events)**

- **How many security staff are present enforcing masks are going to be worn?**
 - We have (3) off duty Police Officers + (1) Supervisor + (2) Police Cars that will be at the entrance and out on Goldwater Blvd to ensure there aren't large crowds gathering on the wall encouraging the cars to speed off. They will also be walking the event site.
 - There will also be (4) Security Guards walking around the venue with signs and reminding attendees that there is a zero-tolerance policy on Masks

- **While the plan notes masks will be worn unless people are eating and drinking, this can be problematic. How are you preventing what we call the Disneyland effect of people just walking around carrying drinks and not wearing their masks? What seems to work from a safety perspective is to have an established seating area where people can sit and enjoy their drink or food but it is not permitted beyond that area.**
 - We will make certain these rules are made clear in our social media/email blasts to attendees.
 - We will have the (16) employees, hired security guards, and volunteers walking around the event giving people 1 warning for not wearing their masks. Failure to comply will result in attendees being asked to leave the premises.
 - The only exception will be if you are taking a drink or eating AT a restaurant on the premises.

- **What protocols are in place if additional car clubs show up for the event? What is the plan if they drift over to this car show foot print?**
 - We have notified everyone on which clubs are not "highlighted" for this event. We've communicated that the Mustangs and Camaro clubs will be scheduled at another event/location throughout the year.
