CDC Guideline Protocol

We encourage all guests to stay home if they have been running a fever, any symptoms, or believed to have been exposed to COVID-19.

All event staff will wear face coverings.

All tickets must be purchased online. This ensures a contactless event. Upon check-in, SLE parking staff will look up the ticket purchaser via a mobile device and no exchange of physical tickets or cash takes place.

All attendees will be required to wear face coverings when outside of their vehicle, visiting restrooms, and/or picking up take-out food.

All cars will have at least a 10 foot space between them.

All guests must sit inside their vehicles or in the immediate area around their vehicle. Face coverings are required and enforced if sitting outside of the vehicle.

All attendees will be required to practice social distancing, keeping at least 10 feet between themselves and others who are not members of their respective parties (no more than 6 people per party).

SLE parking personnel will advise guests of health and safety protocol messaging while checking-in and parking vehicles. Once vehicles are parked, we will transition to health and safety protocol enforcement for the event duration.

Event Producers will provide a dedicated staff to patrol the event footprint by walking along parking rows during the event duration, enforcing face coverings, and social distancing compliance.

Sonora Village staff will clean restrooms regularly during the event duration, including before and after each movie showing.

Guests who do not adhere to these rules of any reason will be escorted off the premises.
