- 2-4 oz. Mod Podge Matte finish or Matte Gel Medium
- 2 oz. white matte acrylic paint
- Flat craft paint brush (½" or ¾" suggested)
- Small round craft paint brush
- Old used credit or gift card
- 2-12x12 sheets scrapbook paper, not cardstock in colors and design of your choice for inside covers. 4-6 additional sheets—any size for collage.
- Fine point permanent marker (Sharpie or Micron 05 or .08 suggested)
