FLAG FOOTBALL AND VOLLEYBALL LEAGUES

The Youth Corps is a summer teen volunteer program for **ages 13-17**. Volunteers can explore career opportunities, give back to the community, and receive school credit (with prior school approval). Various opportunities exist throughout the city, and teens will gain valuable experience while they "work" 10-20 hours a week throughout June and July.

Youth and teen program sites- Assist recreation leaders who run a day program for children 6-11 and participants entering 6th, 7th and 8th grade.

Aquatic fitness centers- Volunteers will assist with front desk duties, gym roves, park roves and organizational tasks.

Office positions- Valuable skills such as answering phone lines, filing paperwork and providing quality customer service are entailed in these positions.

Senior Centers- Assist recreation leaders with daily activities and with front desk duties.

Service projects- These projects give teens an opportunity to contribute to the community through various service projects throughout the summer.
