James Swann, Craft 64's co-owner, says "We source products and ingredients as locally and organically as we possibly can; make our own mozzarella, dough for our artisan wood-fired pizza and focaccia; and partner with local brewers and distilleries." Craft 64 features more than 30 local beers on tap, including eight of their own craft beers brewed at Sun Up Brewery in Phoenix. For summertime, Craft 64 offers four new specialty cocktails and brews. In conjunction with Scottsdale's own Blue Clover Distillery, Craft 64's brand new Clover Kicker mule features Blue Clover's vodka, pamplemousse liqueur and the best ginger beer available; and the Peacemaker includes Roger Clyne's Moonshine Tequila and passion fruit liqueur. Seasonal brews for summer include the Frolic, featuring mosaic hops infused with organic grapefruit; and the Mister Big, an American wheat ale with cucumber and lemon.

Old Town Gringos features a two-level, open-air atmosphere with four bars, tire swing seating, interactive games, live music, DJs spinning tunes into the wee hours of the morning, and full menu service until 2:00 a.m. nightly. With a wide array of tacos, mini sliders, salads and "headliners" such as specialty mac and cheese varieties, fajitas, skewers and burritos on the music- and pop-culture-themed menu, diners won't leave Old Town Gringos hungry. The libations menu offers specialty cocktails and mules with creative themed names such as the popular Iggy Pop mule, featuring fig-flavored Figenza vodka, lime juice and ginger beer. Guests can order their mule "Chris Farley style" - a 96-ounce pour of their preferred mule served in a massive copper mule mug (served to a minimum of four).

INGREDIENTS:

- 1.5 oz. Figenza fig flavored vodka
- 5 oz. fresh squeezed lime juice
- Bundaberg Ginger Beer

PREPARATION:

1. In a shaker glass, add vodka, lime juice and shake
2. Strain into a classic Figenza Copper Mule Mug
3. Top with ginger beer

Dierks Bentley's Whiskey Row opened in Scottsdale in July 2013 as the first ever pop-country nightclub of its kind, combining high-end nightlife amenities such as bottle service with the laid-back vibe of a country bar. With live entertainment every Thursday night, a from-scratch menu with highlights such as the Chicken and Waffles with honey jalapeno glaze and the top-selling Whiskey Burger, popular cocktails such as the Tequila Mockingbird, Spring Fling Redneck Cocktail and the Dierks Lemonade (the latter which is 25 percent off all summer long from May 25-September 3, 2018), there is always a reason to stop into Dierks Bentley Whiskey Row.

DIERKS LEMONADE — DIERKS BENTLEY WHISKEY ROW

INGREDIENTS:

- 1.5 oz. Jack Daniels
- 75 oz. simple syrup
- Handful of fresh raspberries
- 75 oz. Lemon juice
- 1/2 lemonade
- 1/2 soda water

PREPARATION:

1. Put three raspberries in a mixing glass, then add 75 oz. simple syrup and 75 oz. lemon juice and muddle.
2. Add ice and 15 oz. of Jack Daniels into a mixing glass.
