CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

**Pima Freeway ramps closed at 56th Street
Aug. 16 through October 2020**

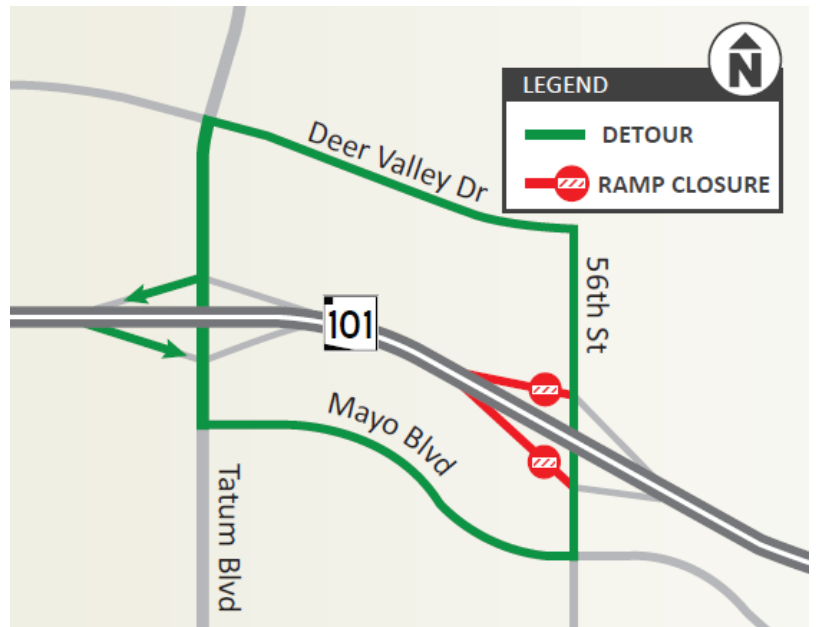
Beginning at 9 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 16, the westbound Pima Freeway on-ramp at 56th Street will be closed through mid-October.

DETOURS: Drivers can use northbound 56th Street to Deer Valley Drive or southbound 56th Street to Mayo Boulevard, and travel west on Mayo Boulevard to north- or southbound Tatum Boulevard to access the Pima Freeway.

Beginning at 9 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 23, the eastbound Pima Freeway off-ramp at 56th Street will be closed through late October.

DETOURS: Drivers can exit at Tatum Boulevard and use northbound Tatum Boulevard to Deer Valley Drive or southbound Tatum Boulevard to Mayo Boulevard, and travel east to access 56th Street.

The closures are needed to reconstruct the ramps to accommodate the new travel lanes on the freeway.
