Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) § 8-323 provides that the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court may appoint magistrates or justices of the peace to serve as juvenile hearing officers. Juvenile hearing officers have the opportunity to continue performing the duties outlined in A.R.S. § 8-323 or to opt out of handling these offenses.

WHEREAS, Maricopa County Superior Court Administrative Order 2002-014 ordered all Municipal Presiding Judges, and their designees, and all Justices of the Peace, and their designees, in the County of Maricopa are appointed juvenile hearing officers for the offenses listed in A.R.S. § 8-323, (excluding graffiti offenses, city, town or political subdivision ordinance violations; second DUI offenses) except for jurisdictions which opt out of handling offenses under A.R.S. § 8-323.

IT IS ORDERED that the Scottsdale City Court's Associate Judges and Scottsdale City Court Pro Tem Judges, be designated as juvenile hearing officers in accordance to Maricopa County Superior Court Administrative Order 2002-014.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall replace Court Order No. 2015-07.
