Arizona Supreme Court Rules 122 and 122.1 allow for the use of portable electronic devices in a courthouse and permit the use of recording devices in a courtroom in some circumstances. Rule 122.1(c)(3) authorizes Scottsdale City Court to adopt further reasonable limits of photography and audio or video recording in a courthouse that are not inconsistent with this rule or with Rule 122.

WHEREAS Rule 122 prohibits the use of a recording device in a courtroom without the prior and express approval of the judge assigned to the courtroom.

WHEREAS Rule 122.1 specifies the permitted use of portable electronic devices in a courthouse, to include areas of the courthouse outside the courtroom.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that no person shall use a recording device in a courtroom without the prior, express permission of the judge assigned to that courtroom.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no person may photograph, record (video or audio), livestream, or broadcast images, video, or audio of any individual in the courthouse without that individual's prior express consent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that activities not prohibited by this order are subject to the authority of judges, or court administrators to limit or terminate activity disruptive to court operations or that compromise courthouse security.
