
ALLOWED NOVELTY ITEMS PER A.R.S. 36-1609 (B)

USE ONLY UNDER CLOSE ADULT Supervision. For Outdoor USE only. Place Upright on Ground. Light Fuse and get away. Do not hold in hand. USE ONLY UNDER CLOSE ADULT SUPERVISION. FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY. STICK FIRMLY IN GROUND IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION, REMOVE CAP FOR LIGHTING. DO NOT HOLD IN HAND. LIGHT FUSE AND GET AWAY.

MAY NOT HAVE MORE THAN 500g OF EXPLOSIVE MIXTURE.

City of Scottsdale Fireworks Bulletin - 6/23/2025

While State Legislation now requires communities in Maricopa and Pima Counties to allow for some specific consumer fireworks sales and use (SB 1158), the City of Scottsdale Ordinance (#4157) clearly defines the parameters for sales, use and specific locations.

Additionally any damage or loss as a result of the use of consumer fireworks is the responsibility of the individual who used these devices. As a result these types of incidents will be investigated and documented in an appropriate format.

Remember, per the National Fire Protection Association;

"Safe and Sane" consumer fireworks are neither. Fountains, novelties and sparklers are designed to throw off showers of hot sparks with temperatures that may exceed 1200 degrees.
