## Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey<sup>TM</sup> (The NCS<sup>TM</sup>), the City of Scottsdale conducted a survey of 1,700 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from November 24, 2020 to January 12, 2021. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Scottsdale. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on January 11, 2021. The survey remained open for four weeks and there were 1,129 responses.


The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and 2017 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Scottsdale. The characteristics used for weighting were age, gender, housing type, housing tenure (rent or own), race, ethnicity and geographic subarea. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.\* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.
