

# KNOW WHAT TO THROW



## **Metal Cans & Aluminum**

Empty and rinse all cans before placing them in the recycling bin. Labels can stay on.



## **Plastic Jugs & Bottles**

Empty and rinse containers before recycling. Keep lids attached to bottles or discard loose lids in the trash.



## **Paper**

Recycle paper separately from other packing materials. Shredded paper is not accepted.



## **Cardboard**

Remove non-recyclable packing materials such as bubble wrap and tape. Discard wet, soiled cardboard and pizza boxes in the trash.

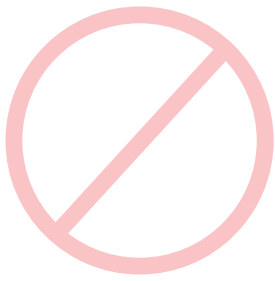


## **Glass**

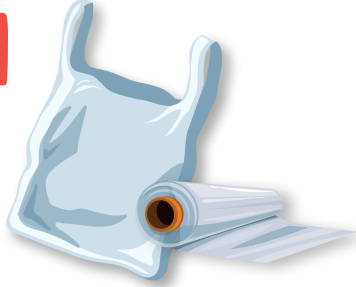
Recycle glass food and beverage containers. You may leave lids and labels on. Empty and rinse all containers before recycling.

# TOP 5 CONTAMINANTS



## **Plastic Bags & Thin Film Plastic**

Do not place plastic bags, wrappers, or film in your recycling bin. Take clean, dry bags to designated store drop-offs.



## **Organic Waste: Food, Green & Animal/Human**

Organic materials—including food scraps, yard waste, pet waste, and diapers—do not belong in the recycling bin. Dispose of these in the trash.



## **Styrofoam**

Styrofoam containers, cups, and packaging are not recyclable. Please place them in the trash.



## **E-Waste & Household Hazardous Waste**

Items like batteries, paint, chemicals, and electronics are hazardous and should never go in the recycling. Schedule a special pickup through the city's Household Hazardous Waste Program.



## **Clothing & Textiles**

Do not place clothing, shoes, or fabrics in the recycling bin. Donate wearable items or find a textile recycling drop-off.
