

Scottsdale provides brush and bulk collection as a convenient way to keep our community safe, clean and beautiful. To help us serve you efficiently:

- Place your brush and bulk piles out no later than 5 a.m. on Monday of your scheduled collection week.
- Material may not be set out earlier than three (3) days before your collection week begins.
- Separate your piles:
 - Green waste (yard clippings, branches, trimmings)
 - Bulk items (everything else)
- Piles should not exceed 10 feet long, 6 feet wide, and 4 feet tall.
- Keep piles at least 3 feet apart from each other and away from walls, fences, mailboxes, utility boxes, and parked cars.

Following these guidelines helps keep our crews safe and our neighborhoods looking their best.




Your pile size limit is equivalent to 6 trash or recycle containers placed in 2 rows of 3 each.

✓ Items We Accept

- Furniture
- Mattresses
- Tree limbs and branches: **no longer than 6 feet and no wider than 12 inches in diameter**
- Small clippings, grass, leaves and any loose material: **bagged and tied**
- Televisions: **CRT, Projection Screen**
- Cacti or century plants: **must be boxed**

✗ Items We Don't Accept

- Dirt, rocks, sod or sand
- Concrete or cement
- Fiberglass materials: **tubs, showers, pool equipment, insulation**
- Construction and remodel debris
- Automobile parts: **engines, body panels, tires and rims**
- Household generated trash
- Hazardous Waste: see QR code to sign up for disposal



Do not place bulk trash on or within three feet of city owned containers or bins, water meters, cable boxes, fire hydrants, block walls or other fixed objects.

Keeping these areas clear protects essential infrastructure and reduces the risk of damage from our collection equipment.



2026 Holiday Collection Schedule

On your scheduled day of collection, please set out your container(s) by 5 a.m. Crews may arrive earlier than normal.


Collection **IS NOT** affected on these 2026 holidays:

- Martin Luther King Jr. Day – Monday, January 19
- Presidents Day – Monday, February 16
- Memorial Day – Monday, May 25
- Juneteenth – Friday, June 19
- Independence Day – Saturday, July 4
- Labor Day – Monday, September 7
- Veterans Day – Wednesday, November 11

Collection **VARIES** on these 2026 holidays:

- New Year's Day – Thursday, January 1
→ Collection moves to next day
- Thanksgiving – Thursday, November 26
→ Collection moves to next day
- Christmas Day – Friday, December 25
→ Collection moves to next service day


- Tube Televisions

No commercial materials will be accepted. Collection events are only for Scottsdale residential utility customers. Please be prepared to show proof of residency in the form of a picture ID and, either a city utility bill or a rent receipt.

Landfill Program: Residential solid waste customers may haul up to 2,000 pounds of trash, brush, or bulk items to the Salt River Landfill once per week by presenting a City of Scottsdale utility bill and a valid driver's license with the same name and service address; additional visits will be charged to the next utility bill, and e-billing customers must print their statement as cellphone copies are not accepted.
